Sessions will be managed and facilitated by members of the "Blitz Committee", including a representative of the CSSS de Vaudreuil-

Soulanges. This will be an opportunity to take positive action and provide compelling evidence of the desire of Vaudreuil-Soulanges residents to have their own hospital.

Awareness Campaign in Vaudreuil-Soulanges

A huge campaign is underway across all 23 municipalities of the MRC Vaudreuil-Soulanges to build community support for a future regional hospital for the CSSS de Vaudreuil-Soulanges.

The next few weeks will see the start of a major regional tour to raise awareness among stakeholders of local organizations and residents of the 23 Vaudreuil-Soulanges municipalities regarding the CSSS de Vaudreuil-Soulanges hospital project. Right now, we need to show our commitment to this vital project for the development of Vaudreuil-Soulanges by rallying community support.

Objectives of the regional tour

The regional tour will be organized into 23 information evenings coordinated by a dynamic, mobile team of people with vision and determination, focusing on the following objectives:

1. To inform and advise participants of the main goals of the project;
2. To demonstrate our commitment to organizing a citizen initiative;
3. To make local residents aware of the importance of coming together and taking action that is simple and practical;
4. To enhance a shared sense of commitment (citizen responsibility) within the region;
5. To ensure objectivity and transparency in information-sharing activities;
6. To demonstrate citizen support (across all age groups) for the project;
7. To collect meaningful feedback on the project and tangible evidence of direct, community-based support;
8. To enhance the positive contribution of a quality regional press bearing a clear and precise message.

Tour Logistics

- ✓ Organization of a meeting schedule (on March 2010) in consultation with the recreation department of each municipality and reservation of an evening in each local community centre.
- ✓ Design of media tools: multimedia presentation, general brochure, distribution of “We all support the hospital” badges, posters, promotional films, actions or initiatives in support, such as resolutions, email messages and similar.
- ✓ Phone contact with individual representatives of local organizations to invite them and their members to a meeting.
